With this system, special education teachers, related service providers, counselors, and administrators can efficiently create, edit, print, import, export, and store IEPs and related special education reports and forms. The program is IDEA compliant and is aligned with state academic standards.



Program Rationale

The traditional use of paper forms for developing IEPs is inefficient and cumbersome.
